Report First online quiz on 17th May 2020

Illuminous – the medical quiz society Students' Section, Medical Education Unit UCMS and GTB Hospital, Delhi

We, at Illuminous are conducting a series of fortnightly online intercollege quizzes titled "Does your Gray matter?" via Google Forms during the quarantine holidays. The poster advertised has been attached with this mail.

Till date we have organised one 45 minute quiz dated 17/05/2020 at 9:00pm. We had over 680 participants registering from different batches from over 70 colleges all over India and abroad (ie, Russia). The college and batch distribution of the students registered have also been attached with this mail. A total of 3 whatsapp groups were formed with around 200 participants per group in order to dessiminate all quiz related information efficiently. Around 380 students finally submitted their responses and took part in the first quiz of the series.

Most of the questions included in the quiz were based on the subjects covered during the first year, namely Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry. The maximum marks that could be scored was 40. The first question was a 10 mark crossword based on the cadeveric images of anatomy. The next 10 questions were one mark each and based on a conceptual understanding of physiology. The next 20 marks had micellenious questions with multiple linked subunits. Most of the questions had one word answers. The screenshots of some of the questions of each type have also been attached.

Scoring was done manually and the names of the top 15 scorers were announced on the whatsapp groups. The highest scorer was a student of 2017 batch (AIIMS Delhi) with a total score of 31.5. The list of the top scorers of the first quiz has also been attached with this mail. The combined topper of all the quizzes will be awarded an online question bank. Participation certificates have been provided to all the participants of the first quiz.


