C. A report of the four programs/ workshops organized is given below

1. 3rd Workshop on ETHICS and GCP (Evaluation and Training in Human research for Institutional Committees' Standardization and Good Clinical Practices) on 30th Jan 2018

The Institutional Ethics Committee – Human Research and Medical Education Unit, UCMS, jointly organized a workshop on 30th January 2018 in UCMS. The Workshop was titled "3rd Workshop on ETHICS and GCP (Evaluation and Training in Human research for Institutional Committees' Standardization and Good Clinical Practices). The workshop was organized in the Committee Room of College Building, First Floor.

The objectives of this workshop were:



- To strengthen and empower the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC) members to ensure that they understand scientific, regulatory norms, ethical design, conduct and reporting of clinical research that will be of uniform nature and meets national and international quality standards
- Identify, discuss and resolve ethical issues during the process of review
- Review latest guidelines in Biomedical ethics

The participants of this workshop included the members of the IEC-HR, UCMS and also few faculty members of UCMS. There was a felt need to organize another workshop shortly for other interested faculty members from the college who could not be accommodated in the workshop this time.

2. Thesis Writing Workshop for second year Posgraduate students on 17th Feb 2018

The Thesis writing workshop was held on 17th Feb 2018 in LT-4, 5th Floor of UCMS. The objectives of the workshop were:

1. To enable the second year postgraduate students to identify the major issues related to the various sections of a thesis.

2. To discuss and resolve queries of the students regarding thesis writing.

Around 70 postgraduate students attended the workshop and the informal feedback obtained was quite encouraging.

3. MEU- Hour program on 6th March 2018

A new initiative has been launched by the MEU committee, UCMS and GTB Hospital to have a common platform for medical faculty, residents and undergraduate students to discuss on medical education related topics. This will be a one hour program on Tuesdays and held once in each quarter. The first one was held on 6th Mar 2018 in LT-1 and was attended by faculty, residents and undergraduate students. The topic of discussion was Competency Based Medical Education. The general concepts of Competency



based education, evidence-sharing on the topic, and a sample model of CBME was presented followed by discussion.

This was a highly interactive workshop and the faculty members practiced sample size calculation on their laptops using the sample size softwares such as Epi-Info, PS and Gpower. The feedback obtained is highly encouraging. More activities related to statistics will also be taken up depending upon a detailed study of the feedback obtained.
