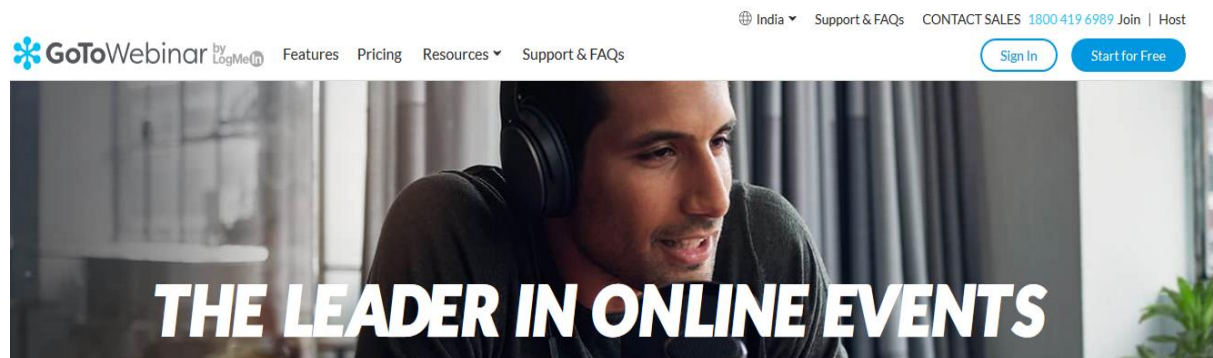

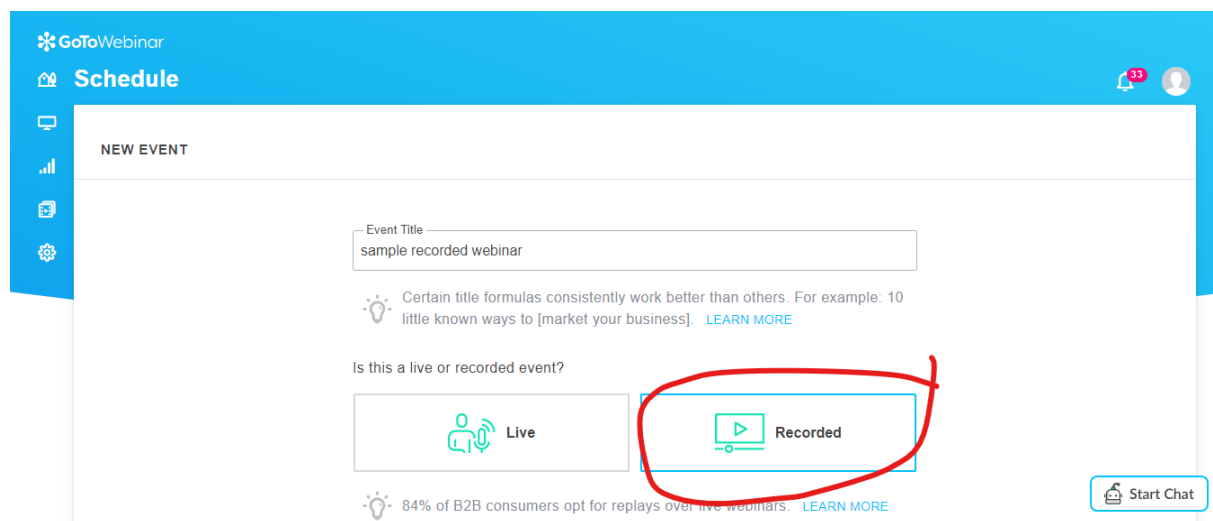
Log in the www.gotowebinar.com website. Join the website by using the login id and password associated with your licence.

You will go to the following page where you can see earlier recordings of the lectures which have been conducted using the licence which you are using. You can type the name of your lecture and search from the recordings.

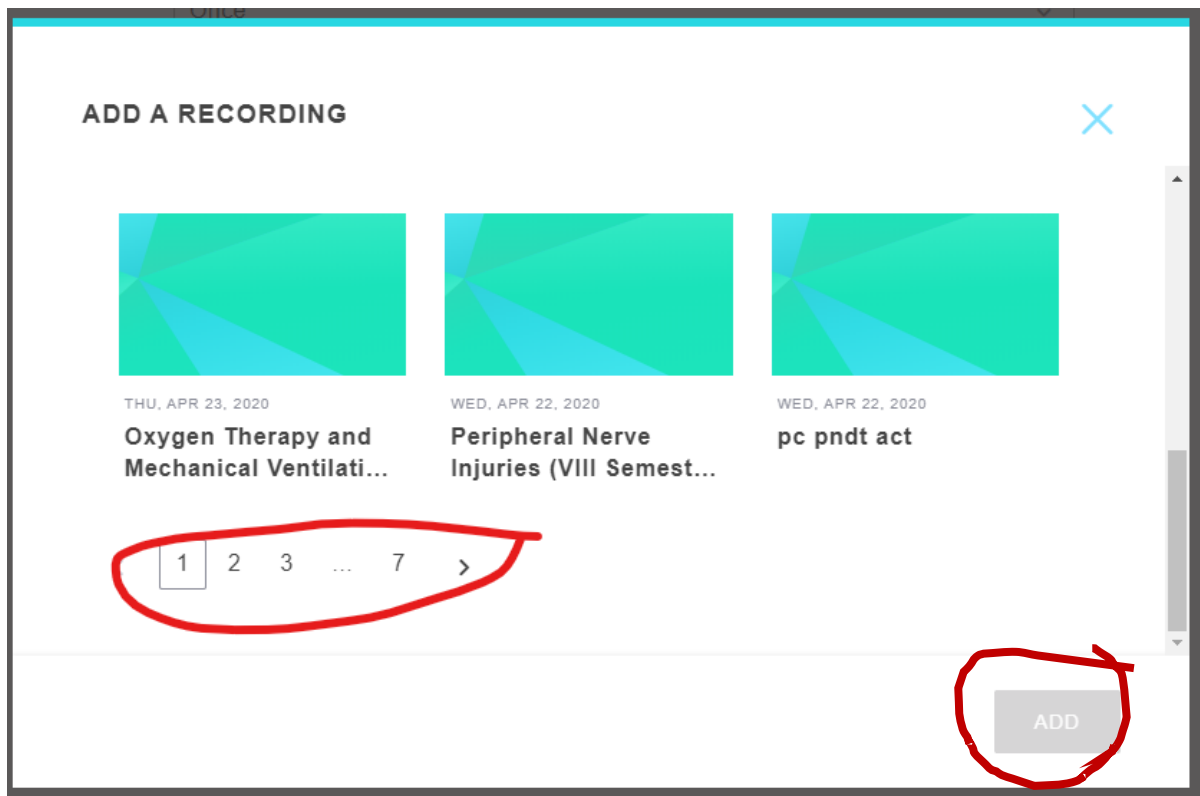

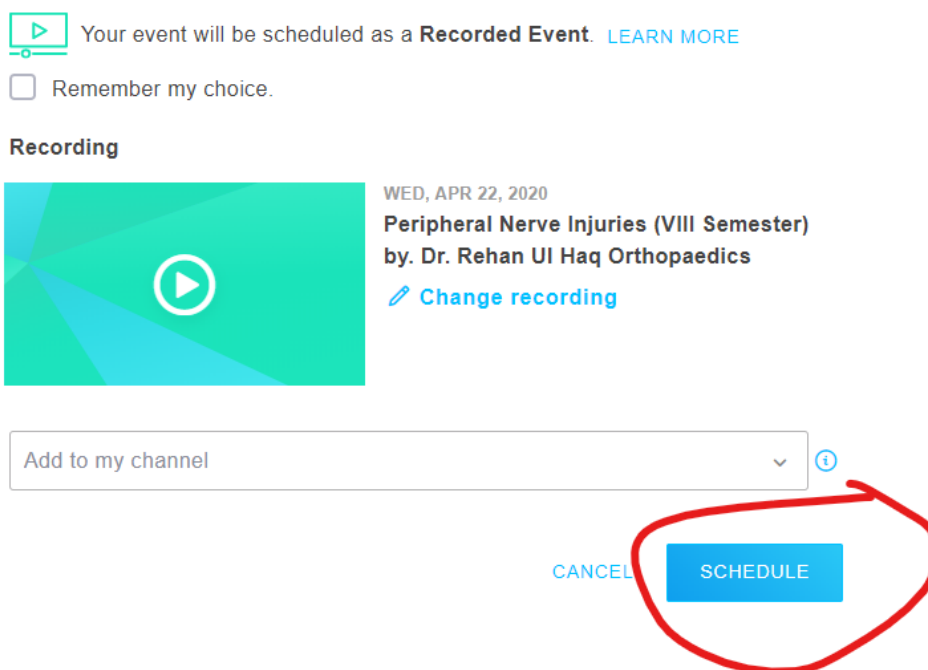

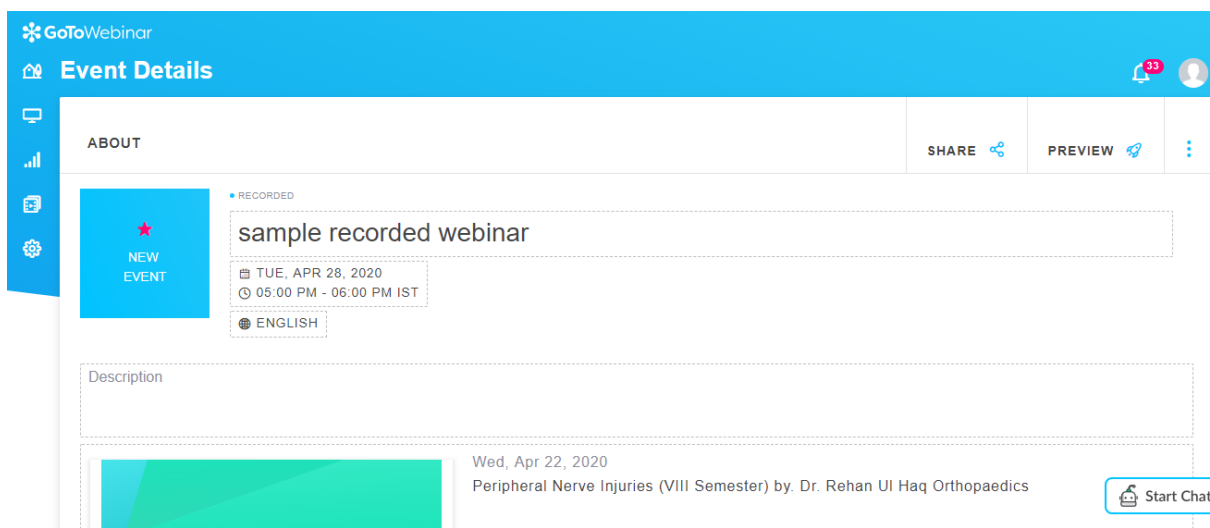

Going below on the same page, you can even search by looking at each page as highlighted in the screenshot below. Select the lecture you want to add and then click on the button ADD on the page given below.

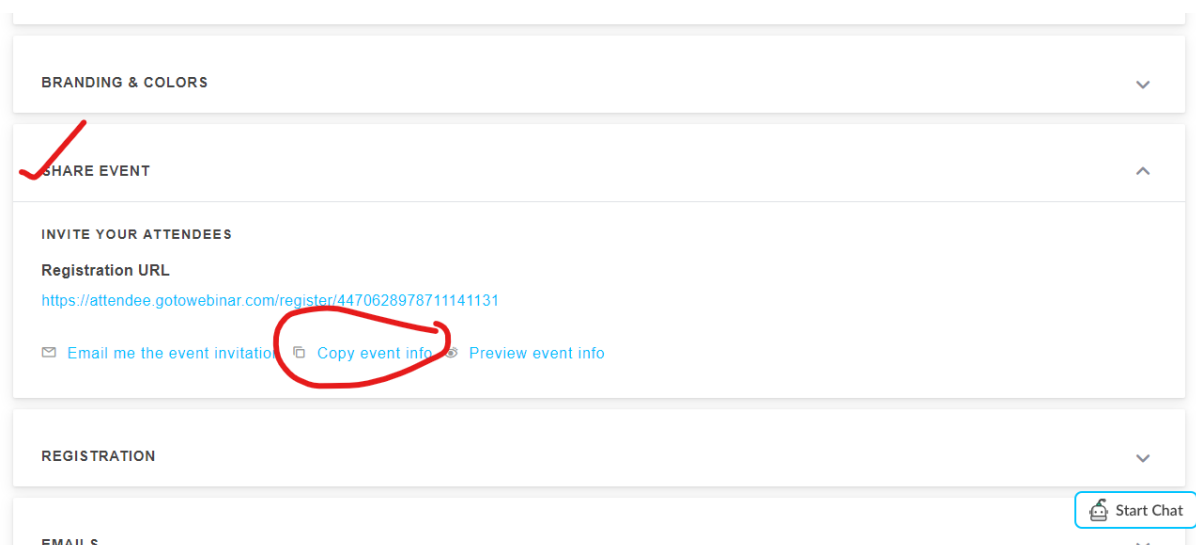


Once you select and ADD the lecture recording, you will see that the recording has been linked now.
