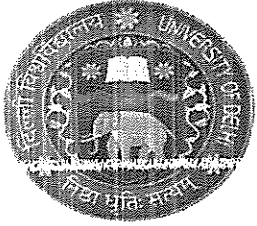

Sub : Matter relating to partial amendment in UG (MBBS) Ordinance 2019 onwards – regarding.

Madam/Sir,

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, in exercising of his emergency powers in terms of Statute 11 G (4) of the Statutes of the University of Delhi has approved the following recommendations of the Faculty of Medical Sciences for partial amendment in the UG (MBBS) Ordinance 2019 onwards in the light of the Circular No. U/14021/8/2023 – UGMEB dated 01.08.2023 issued by NMC which would be applicable for all the (MBBS) batches 2019 onwards from the academic session 2023 onwards :

Existing provision in MBBS Ordinance 2019	Proposed changes as per CBME Regulation 2023- NMC
<p><u>Clause 11.2.5 Page no. 23</u></p> <p>There shall be one main examination in an academic year and a supplementary to be held not later than 90 days after the declaration of the results of the main examination.</p>	<p><u>Clause 11.2.5 Page no. 23</u></p> <p><u>As per CBME 2023 at page 44 (Para 5 & 6)</u></p> <p>At the end of each professional year university examination will be conducted. If any student fails to clear university examination, he will appear in supplementary examination.</p> <p>Supplementary examination and declaration of results shall be processed within 3-6 weeks from the declaration of the results of the main examination for every professional year, so that the candidates, who pass can join the main batch for progression</p> <p>If the candidate fails in the supplementary examination of first MBBS, he shall join the batch of next academic /subsequent year. There shall be no supplementary batches. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt</p> <p>(will be applicable for all the batches 2019 onwards from the academic session 2023 onwards)</p> <p>Explanation for ease of understanding related to CBME Course Curriculum issued by NMC dated 13.09.2023 (FAQs)</p> <p>Note : If the student's attendance is less than 75% for theory and less than 80% for practical / clinical training, the student cannot appear in supplementary examination following the regular annual examination. Such student is required to take classes with junior batch commencing in the next academic year to compensate for his attendance deficit, especially the course, has as missed. He will be eligible to appear in the examination in the next academic year only.</p>



<p>Table 10 (a) : Marks distribution for various subjects in final examination</p> <p>Page no. 24 and 25</p> <p>Passing Criteria</p> <p>University Examination</p> <p>Mandatory 50% marks separately in theory and practical (practical = practical / clinical)</p> <p>In subjects that have two papers, the learner must secure at least 40% marks in each of the papers with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass in the said subject.</p>	<p>Table 10 (a) : Marks distribution for various subjects in final examination</p> <p>Page no. 24 and 25</p> <p>Passing Criteria</p> <p>As per CBME 2023 (Page 75) :Table 10: Marks distribution for various subjects for University Annual Examinations</p> <p>Passing criteria</p> <p>Mandatory to get 40% marks separately in theory and in practicals, and totally 50% for theory plus practicals.</p> <p>(will be applicable for all the batches 2019 onwards from the academic session 2023 onwards)</p>

The matter will be reported to the Academic Council and Executive Council of the University of Delhi.
This is being issued with the approval of the Competent Authority.
You are requested to take necessary action in accordance with the above decision.
