

Details of the workshop

The MIYCN National Working Group of IAPSM, in collaboration with the IAPSM Delhi Chapter and the Department of Community Medicine, UCMS and GTB Hospital, Delhi, conducted a workshop on "Development of an implementation framework for teaching MIYCN to medical undergraduates under the Competency based curriculum". The workshop took place on 27th March 2024 at UCMS, Delhi, and was attended by 24 participants from various medical colleges in Delhi and the National Capital Region. The participants included faculty members from the Departments of Community Medicine, Pediatrics, and Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

Dr. S K Bhasin, Professor and Head of the Department of Community Medicine at UCMS, Delhi, delivered the welcome address at the beginning of the workshop. This was followed by keynote speeches from Dr. Pragti Chhabra, Chair of MIYCN-IAPSM, Dr. SK Rasania, President of IAPSM Delhi Chapter, Dr. Richa Singh from UNICEF, Delhi, and Dr. Kapil Yadav, Convener of the MIYCN Core Group at AIIMS, Delhi. The speakers emphasized the importance of alignment & Integration in medical education and stressed the significance of MIYCN for medical undergraduates. They highlighted that MIYCN is a crucial expertise that all doctors should possess, regardless of the specialty they choose later in their careers.

Dr. Khan Amir Maroof, Secretary of MIYCN-IAPSM, outlined the objectives of the workshop, which aimed to create an integrated curricular framework for teaching MIYCN. He pointed out that there is significant overlap in competencies between the Departments of Community Medicine, Pediatrics, and Obstetrics and Gynaecology. Additionally, he noted that the topic of MIYCN is also covered by the Departments of Anatomy, Physiology, and Biochemistry. Therefore, he emphasized the need for collaboration among these relevant departments to develop a framework.

It was followed by group work and Thematic discussion on Skill training in MIYCN as well as on overlapping competencies with the help of resource materials shared among the participants.

Dr. Khan Amir Maroof mentioned that the initial step towards creating a framework is for the curriculum committee of a college to acknowledge MIYCN as an AITO topic and to include it in the curriculum time table. He invited colleges for expression of interest via email and stated that those colleges interested in developing this framework would receive training on how to impart the skills discussed during the workshop.

The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Somdatta Patra, Professor from the Department of Community Medicine at UCMS, Delhi.
